RESCHEDULING OF THE AFRIKAANS HOME LANGUAGE PAPER 3 AND THE AFRIKAANS FIRST ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE PAPER 3 MAY/JUNE 2019 SENIOR CERTIFICATE (SC) EXAMINATION AND NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE (NSC) EXAMINATION QUESTION PAPERS

The May/June 2019 Senior Certificate (SC) and National Senior Certificate (NSC) examinations commenced on Thursday, 2 May 2019 and was concluded on Friday, 14 June 2019.

Due to the national elections that took place on Wednesday, 8 May 2019, subjects that were to be written on Tuesday, 7 May 2019, Wednesday, 8 May 2019 and Thursday, 9 May 2019 were rescheduled to be written on 11 to 14 June 2019.



Candidates were appraised of these changes; however, a total of 184 candidates missed out on the writing of the Afrikaans Home Language Paper 3 and another 59 candidates missed out on the writing of the Afrikaans First Additional Language Paper 3 question papers which were written on Tuesday, 11 June 2019 at 9:00.

This mainly affects the two predominantly Afrikaans speaking provinces, i.e. the Northern Cape and Western Cape provinces. As these examinations are predominantly scheduled to be written in the afternoons at 14:00, the candidates did not notice that the subject would be written during the morning session.

The Department of Basic Education has resolved to accommodate these candidates by supplying back-up papers in both Afrikaans Home Language Paper 3 and Afrikaans First Additional Language Paper 3.

These papers will be rewritten on Thursday, 11 July 2019 at 14:00 at the various centres involved. Only candidates who did not write the examination question paper on Tuesday, 11 June 2019 will be allowed to participate in the rewrite. Candidates who have already written the question paper will not be allowed to rewrite the specific question papers.

The Northern Cape Department of Education's Examinations and Assessment Chief Directorate has put all processes in place to prepare for the rewrite of the particular question papers. Chief Invigilators are requested to make the necessary arrangements to accommodate candidates on said date and to supply the names of any candidate that they are aware of who are affected by the rescheduling to the relevant District Officials.
