

# SCHOOL SELF-EVALUATION (SSE)

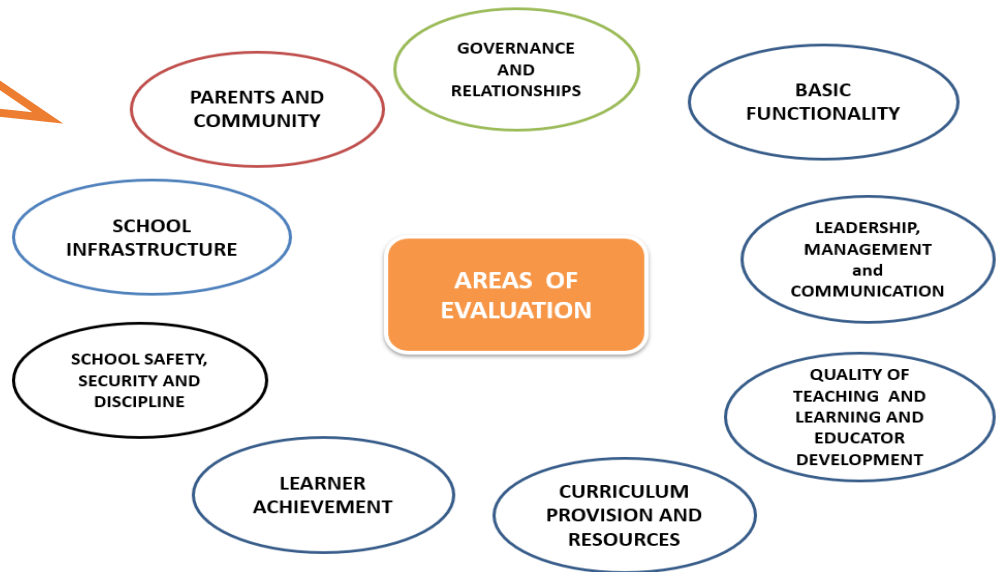
## WHAT IS SSE?

School self-evaluation is the process by which a school is able to look critically at itself (REFLECT) in order to improve further the QUALITY of its provision and its performance.

## WHO IS INVOLVED IN UNDERTAKING SSE?

The school stakeholder community is responsible for undertaking SSE, this includes teachers; SMT; SGB and PS Staff.

The school stakeholders should reflect upon the nine areas of evaluation as set out in the WSE POLICY.



## WHEN to do SSE?

SEPTEMBER or OCTOBER

## TAKING SSE TO A MATTER BEYOND COMPLIANCE – KEY ACTIONS REQUIRED...

1. Did ALL stakeholders engage in the self-reflective process?
2. Were ALL nine focus areas completed?
3. Is there evidence for the responses?
4. Are COMMENTS indicated for the responses coded in RED?
5. Are the MAIN FINDINGS recorded?
6. Were the priorities for inclusion in the SIP identified?
7. Have these priorities been included in the SIP for the next academic year?
8. Was the SSE report submitted to the Circuit Manager?
9. Was the SSE DATA subsequently captured on the online system?
10. ALL officials visiting a school should engage with the information from the SSE for their particular area of responsibility.
