- Are an unemployed youth who passed Matric with an "Admission to Bachelor's Degree Studies?"
- Are a South African citizen who is 30 years and below

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE:



### Process for citizens to use the Funza Lushaka Information Management System

#### Step 1: e-Gov Portal

Open the e-Gov Portal:  
[www.eservices.gov.za](http://www.eservices.gov.za)



#### Step 2: Login or Register

Login with your previous login details, or Register a new account. Enter the OTP (One Time Pin) to complete the process



#### Step 3: Menu selection

On the e-Services menu, choose Funza Lusaka Bursary.



#### Step 4: T's and C's

Accept the Funza Lushaka terms and conditions to proceed.

#### Step 5: Apply

On the Dashboard menu, click on the Application button. Follow the steps to complete the required fields with your information.

#### Step 6: Declaration

Accept the declaration to confirm the information captured. Receive electronic feedback on the status of the application via email.

## STEP BY STEP:



1. Apply online for admission to a B.Ed. at a university and obtain a valid student number.
2. Consider the priority subjects of the Northern Cape when choosing your combination at university.
3. Complete the Screening Form available at all District Offices.
4. Attach ALL supporting documents (Grade 11 results, Grade 12 June results/Matric Certificate, ID copy, University acceptance letter, if available, Police Clearance).
