#### COMMEMORATION OF FREEDOM DAY - 27 APRIL 2018

On the 27 April 2018, our country will celebrate the 24th Anniversary of our freedom when we commemorate Freedom Day. We once again will celebrate the anniversary of our first democratic elections held in1994, in which South Africans of all races voted for the first time.

The Northern Cape Department of Education acknowledges this day as a special day, as it inspires all South Africans, to renew our commitment to uphold human rights, human dignity and equality for all people. The theme for Freedom day will be: The year of Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela: "United for Radical Socio - Economic Transformation".

### Through this theme our department will focus on the following objectives:

- To remember the life of Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela by highlighting the progress made in advancing and restoring human dignity as we celebrate Madiba's Centenary year
- To remember the life of Albertina Sisulu, highlighting her values as an unsung heroine.
- To commemorate the 40<sup>th</sup> years of the passing of Robert Sobukwe by highlighting freedom and advance in the promotion of human rights.
- Foster Nation Building and Social Cohesion through National Identity, Patriotism and our National Symbols and thus encourage Social Cohesion amongst our learners, educators and the broader school communities. Identifying and celebrating untold stories and unsung heroes and heroines in every community and every workplace.



As part of the celebrations, all schools are expected to celebrate the day with our annual flag hoisting ceremonies on **Thursday**, <u>26 April 2017</u>, <u>at 08:00 am</u>. This flag hoisting ceremonies form part of the ongoing process of our National Identity Campaign which was launched in February 2016, where our learners must sing our national anthem, sing the AU anthem, recite the preamble of our Constitution and reinforces the motto in the Coat of Arms, !KE E:/XARRA//KE, which means: "diverse people unite".

#### Suggested school activities could include the following:

- Engage in hoisting and lowering the national flag on a daily basis so as to inculcate a culture of patriotism and respect for our national flag and symbols. Organizing displays of the national flag(murals, floral designs and other imaginative ways)
- Critically evaluating school symbols and their appropriateness by holding discussions with all stakeholders in the school community, particularly around issues of identity, diversity and integration.
- Exhibiting displays made by learners, depicting a Freedom Charter for the school.
- Story-telling by elders in the community on the lives of Nelson Mandela, Albertina Sisulu and Robert Sobukwe.
- Guest speakers to talk about freedom, peace, democracy and the values of Nelson Mandela, Albertina Sisulu and Robert Sobukwe.
- Music, Art or Drama, depicting themes opposing racism, sexism, xenophobia, chauvinism, genocide and the timeline history of Nelson Mandela, Albertina Sisulu and Robert Sobukwe.
- Inter-school activities on school enrichment, like cross-gender sporting activities, debating, etc.

Protocol instructions on how to hoist the flag is found on P28 and P29 of the book, My Country, South Africa: Celebrating our National Symbols and Heritage. Schools are also encouraged to ask their nearest South African Police Services (SAPS) to assist them with the hoisting of the flag. The programme will start at 08h00 and will finish at 08h30 in the morning, as per proposed schedule (Annexure A). Schools will also be visited and monitored by officials from the department, local councilors and politicians. A detailed deployment list will be forwarded to districts as soon as the list is finalized. These celebrations at schools will culminate in the Provincial Freedom Day Celebration, which will be hosted in Olifantshoek/Kuruman, John Toalo Gaetsewe district on Friday, 27 April 2018.
