SUBJECT: CALL FOR SCHOOLS TO REGISTER FOR THE 2020 DEPARTMENT OF BASIC EDUCATION SPELLING BEE SOUTH AFRICA AND READING CLUBS PROGRAMME

As part of the Read to lead Campaign the Department of Basic Education (DBE) hosted the DBE Spelling Bee South Africa (National Spelling Bee championship) at UNISA in Pretoria on 21 September 2019. This is a campaign to improve learner performance in languages, especially in English. Spelling Bee is a game in which the participants compete in spelling words orally. The Spelling Bee targets learners in Grade 4 to 6 (Intermediate Phase).

The Northern Cape Department of Education believes that participation in the Spelling Bee will enhance the quality of learning and teaching, thereby resulting in improved learner performance.

The 2019 National Spelling Bee season started with schools responding to the call to register for the competition by completing a registration form. All schools are invited to participate in the 2020 Spelling Bee Competition. There is tremendous growth in the number of schools that enrolled to participate in the competition. The Intermediate phase (Grade 4-6) is the only category for the competition and winners will proceed to the National championships. Schools are requested to encourage learners to participate in the competition. The competition will be held in **English** only.
